Dortmund Intermodellbau

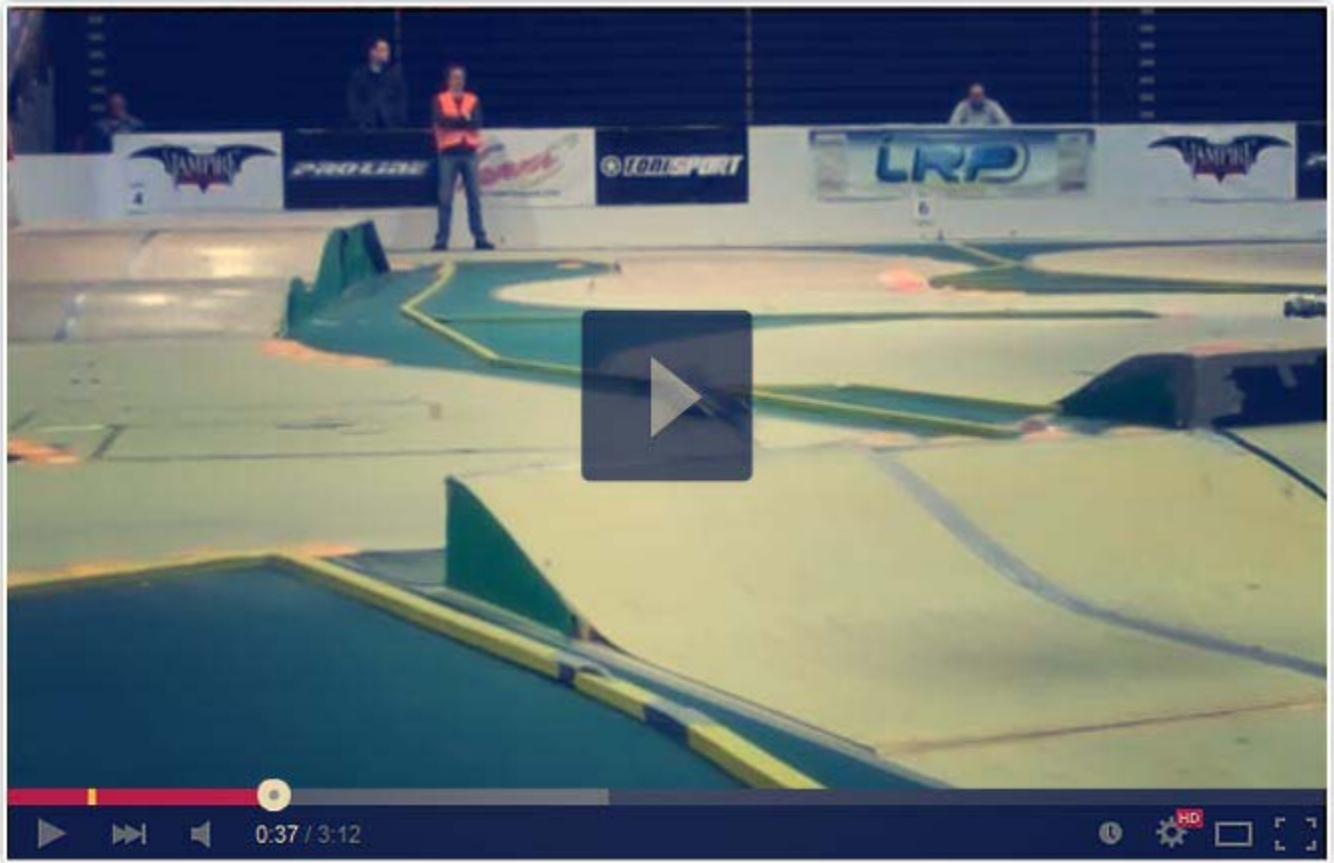

Dresden-Steam Locomotive Fest



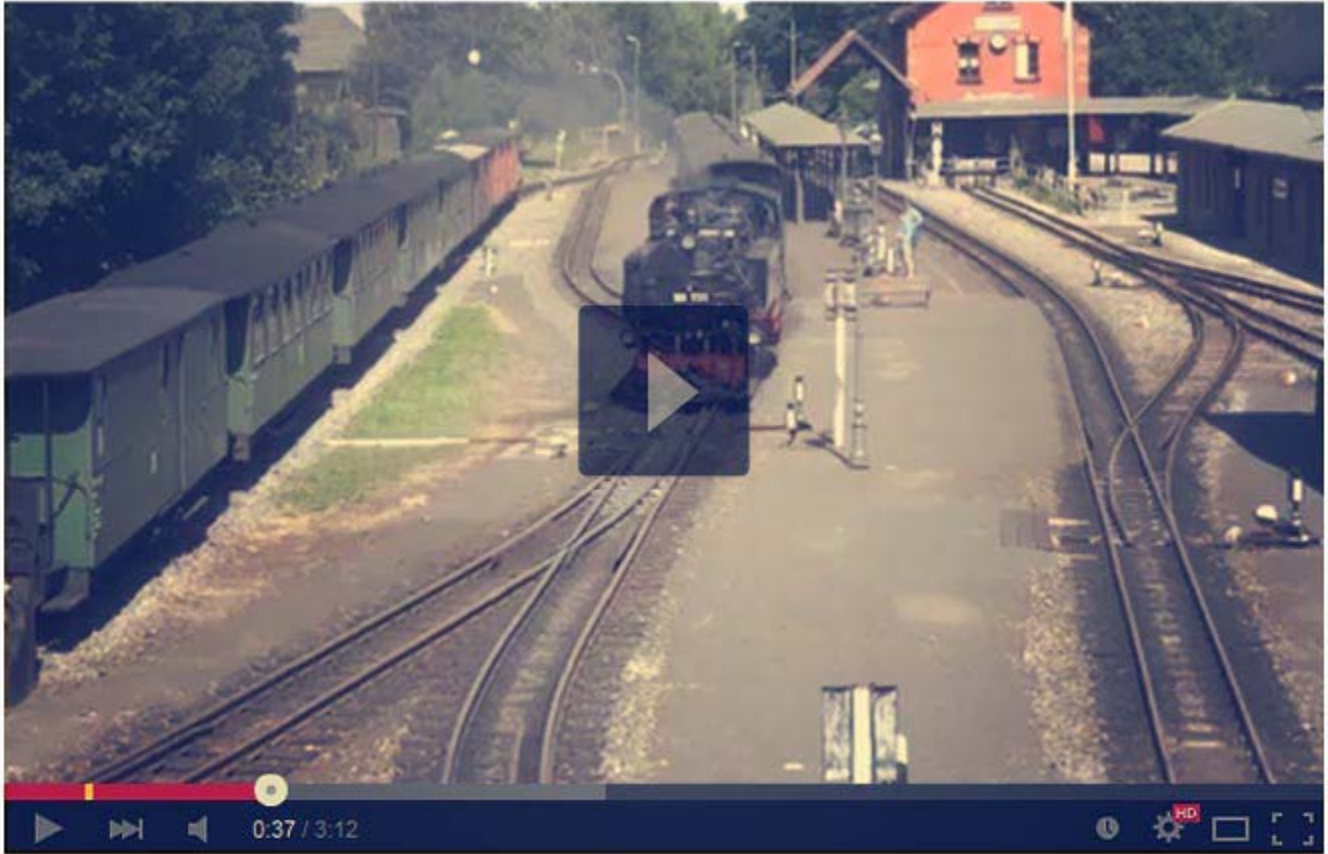
Steam Locomotive ride through the beautiful Elbe Valley

Dresden-Zittau-Oybin



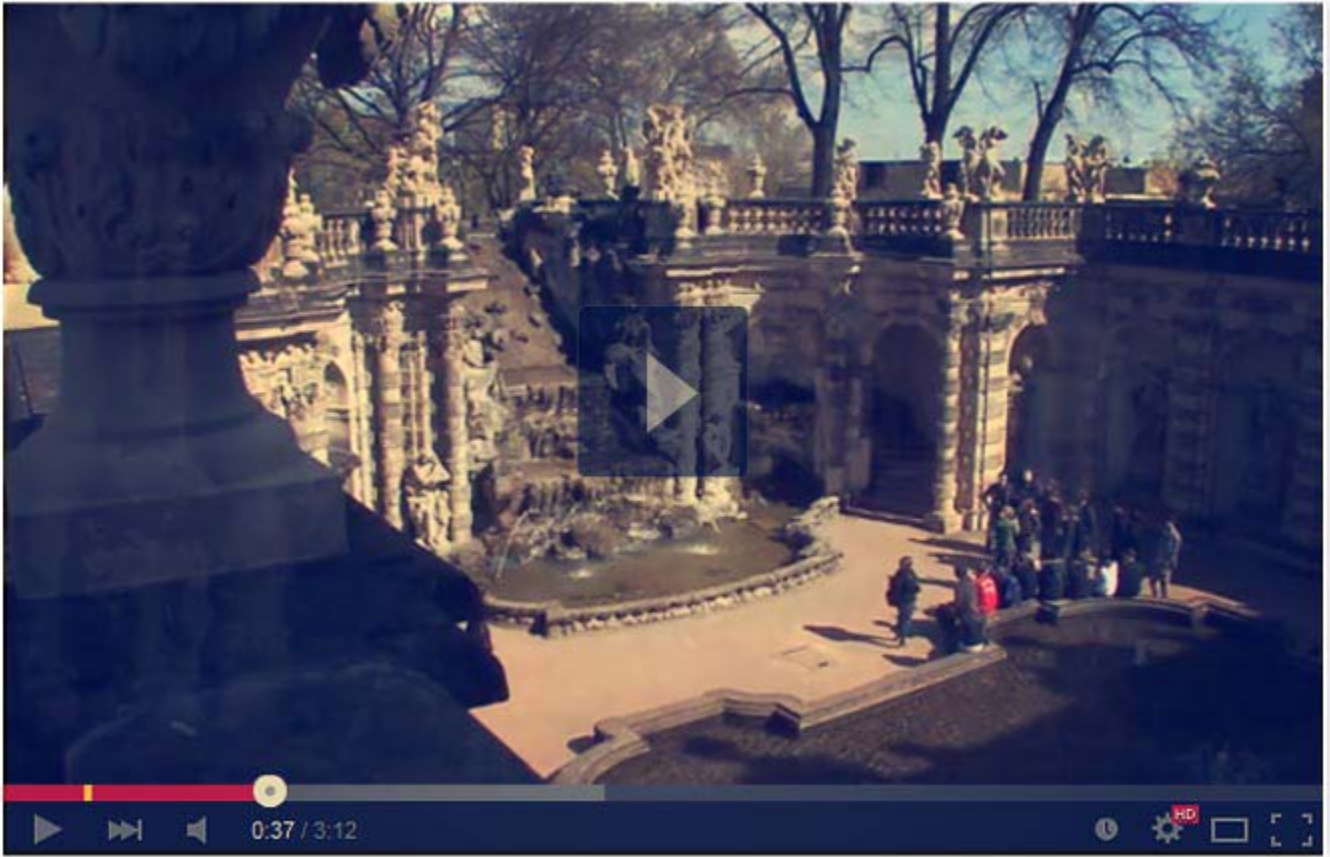
Narrow Gauge Steam Ride

Dresden-City Tour Sightseeing

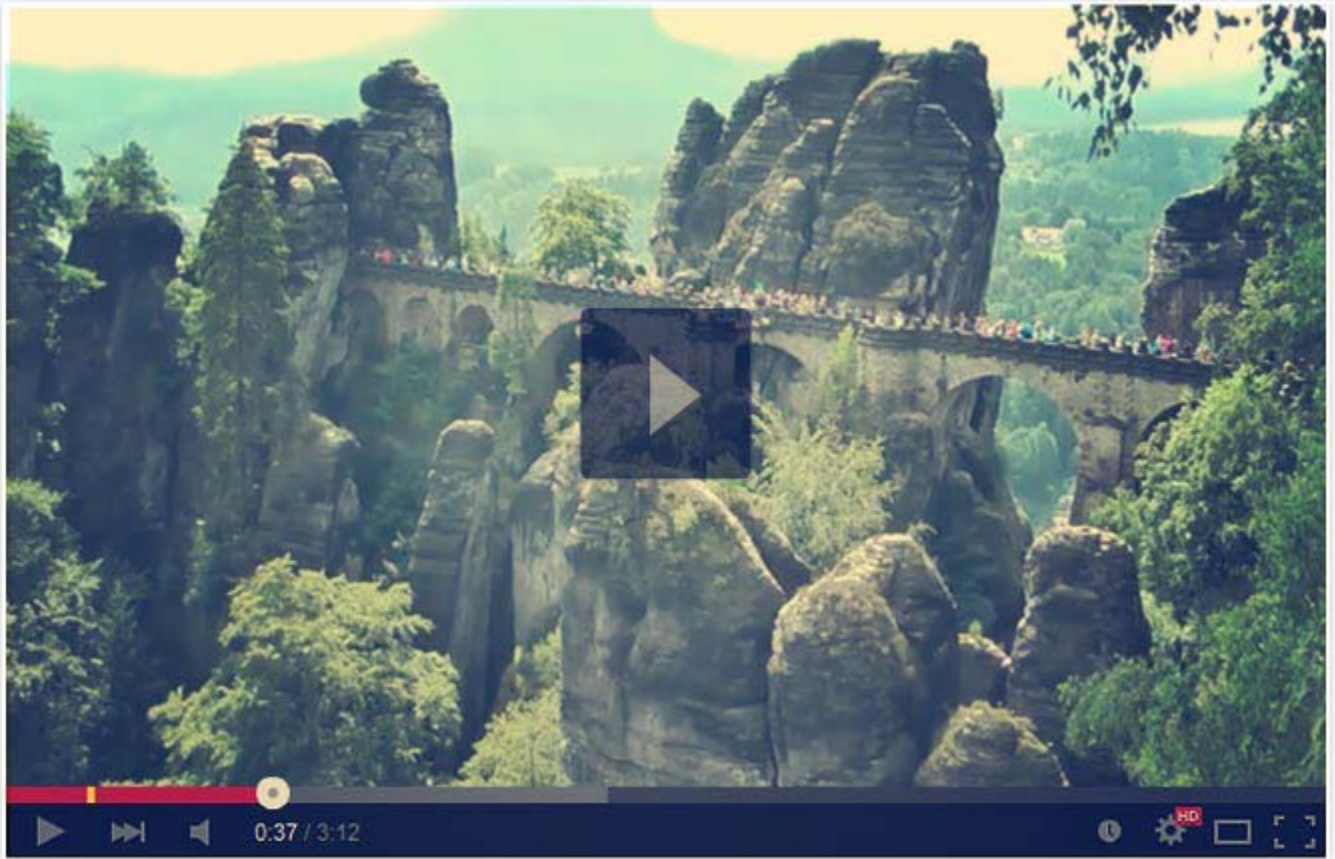
