



TOY FAIR TOUR 2018

Chicago-Munich (or Frankfurt)

Hamburg-City and Airbus Factory Tour

It is the world's largest passenger airliner, a double-deck, wide-body, four engine airplane. Hamburg-Dagebüll



To the coast we go. We take a special train car from Hamburg to the shores of the North Sea. This is the last special service of the German railroad, where they couple 2 cars with this specific destination to a regular Intercity train. In Niebüll the train service is taken over by the privately owned Norddeutsche Eisenbahngesellschaft. This train brings us all the way to the North Sea. From there you could take a ferry to some German islands or even Denmark.
