## Day 1, Friday, January 30 Chicago-Frankfurt




We are leaving Chicago late afternoon on your non-stop flight to Frankfurt. Cocktails and dinner will be served en route.

Lichtenfels – Leipzig





(Goethe wrote parts of his drama Faust there). Thomas Church with Johann Sebastian Bach memorial, Gewandhaus and the Völkerschlachtdenkmal are also included.

## Day 6, Wednesday, February 04 Lichtenfels - Hamburg



Well, our days in Bavaria are over and today we will head to Hamburg. We will board our ICE, which will bring us to Hamburg within 5 hours. After we settle in our new hotel, we give you the rest of the day off to relax or do as you wish.

## Day 7, Thursday, February 05 Hamburg-City and Harbor Tour
